THE HIGHLAND COUNCIL PROPOSE TO CONSTRUCT 1 RAISED TABLE JUNCTION B862 DORES, INVERNESS-SHIRE

Statement of Reasons

In the interests of road safety, in particular to improve road safety for those walking and wheeling in the community and to support a reduction in vehicle speeds with the recent introduction of the 20 mph speed limit, it is proposed to install a raised table junction on the B862, Dores.

This raised table is one of several traffic calming and speed reduction measures of the planned Dores Village Improvement Scheme. This Scheme was developed under the Council's established South Loch Ness – Road Improvement Strategy to improve safety, slow and manage traffic and generally improve the road environment and amenity of Dores Village. Community Consultation for the Scheme was carried out in February 2020 with positive community support and feedback provided. This raised table junction will serve the Cemetery extension and a current proposal for 17 housing units. It is expected that further and complimentary traffic calming/speed reduction measures will be delivered as part of the housing development in due course.
