THE HIGHLAND COUNCIL (INVERNESS SOUTHERN DISTRIBUTOR ROUTE B8082, SIR WALTER SCOTT DRIVE / HOLM ROAD)(40 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2002

The Highland Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the said Act, hereby make the following Order:-

- This Order may be cited as "The Highland Council (Inverness Southern Distributor Route B8082, Sir Walter Scott Drive / Holm Road)(40mph Speed Limit) Order 2002" and shall come into operation on 13 May 2002.
- The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- All provisions contained in any Order enactment or others insofar as the same repeat or are inconsistent with the provisions of this Order and the true intent and meaning hereof shall cease to have effect and are hereby revoked.
- 4 No person shall drive, or cause or permit any vehicle to be driven at a speed in excess of 40 mph on the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.

Route B8082, Sir Walter Scott Drive/ Holm Road from its junction with Route B862 Fort Augustus - Inverness Road (Dores Road), eastwards, then northeastwards to a point 35 metres or thereby northeast of the centreline of North Beechwood Park a distance of 5497 metres or thereby
