

**THE HIGHLAND COUNCIL (C1032 BARN CHURCH ROAD & VARIOUS ROADS, INVERNESS) (30MPH AND 40MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2025**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that The Highland Council proposes to make an Order in terms of Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 entitled as above.

If the Order comes into force, the Order will introduce a 30mph speed limit on the following roads in Culloden over their entire length, unless stated otherwise below:

C1032 Barn Church Road from its junction with the A96 (Aberdeen – Inverness Trunk Road) to a point 120 metres, or thereby, south-east of its junction with Smithton Road, a total distance of 965 metres or thereby.

If the Order comes into force, the Order will introduce a 40mph speed limit on the following roads in Culloden over their entire length, unless stated otherwise below:

C1032 Barn Church Road from point 120 metres, or thereby, south-east of its junction with Smithton Road to a point 73 metres, or thereby, north-east of its junction with Moray Park Avenue, a total distance of 1730 metres, or thereby; C1036 Tower Road from its junction with the C1032 Barn Church Road to a point 40 metres, or thereby, south of its junction with Murray Road, a total distance of 473 metres, or thereby; U5410 Birch Court; U5578 Beith Place; U5143 Smithton Industrial Estate.

A copy of the proposed Order, together with a copy of the relevant plan, the Authority's Statement of Reasons for proposing to make the Order along with the THE HIGHLAND REGIONAL COUNCIL (SMITHTON AND BALLOCH, INVERNESS) (SPEED LIMITS) ORDER 1995 which will be revoked in part if the proposed order comes into force can be inspected at the Inverness Service Point, Town House, Castle Street, Inverness, IV1 1JJ from 8<sup>th</sup> August 2025 to 6<sup>th</sup> September 2025 during normal opening hours, 10:00-12:30 and 13:30-16:30.
