

THE HIGHLAND COUNCIL
PROPOSE TO CONSTRUCT 1 RAISED TABLE WITH UNCONTROLLED
PEDESTRIAN CROSSING ON A99 HIGH STREET, WICK AND 1 RAISED TABLE
WITH UNCONTROLLED PEDESTRIAN CROSSING ON A99 BRIDGE STREET,
WICK

SCHEDULE

The Highland Council, in terms of the powers contained in section 36 of the **Roads (Scotland) Act 1984** as amended and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf propose to construct the 1 raised table on the A99 High Street, Wick and 1 raised table on the A99 Bridge Street as follows:

Raised table with uncontrolled pedestrian crossing A99 High Street, Wick:-

- 61 metres or thereby Southeast of the U3664 Whitechapel Road/A99 High Street Junction, Wick

Raised table with uncontrolled pedestrian crossing A99 Bridge Street, Wick:-

- 11 metres or thereby Northeast of the U3810 Back Bridge Street/A99 Bridge Street Junction, Wick

The raised tables are 75mm in height (max) across the carriageway kerb to kerb. This consists of a raised section (75mm in height) 2700 mm wide on top with two tapered ramps located on each side 2000 mm in width.
