

THE HIGHLAND COUNCIL (U3810 BACK BRIDGE STREET, WICK) (STOPPING UP) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that The Highland Council proposes to make an Order in terms of Section 68(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 entitled as above.

If the Order comes into force, the U3810 Back Bridge Street, Wick will be stopped up as described below subject to the reservation of a means of passage for pedestrians and pedal cyclists:

- a. commencing at its junction with the B9159 High Street extending in a south westerly direction for a distance of 76m or thereby.
- b. commencing at its junction with the A99 Bridge Street extending in a south easterly direction for a distance of 13m or thereby.

A copy of the proposed Order, together with a copy of the relevant plan, the Authority's Statement of Reasons for proposing to make the Order can be inspected at the Wick Service Point, Caithness House, Market Square, Wick, KW1 4AB, from xxth Month 2025 to xxth Month 2025 during normal opening hours - Mon to Fri: 0930 – 1230 and 13:30 – 16:00.
