CONSULTATION ON POSSIBLE PROPOSAL FOR A MASTERPLAN CONSENT AREA SCHEME

The Highland Council wishes to engage with the local community on a possible proposal for a Masterplan Consent Area (MCA) Scheme. An MCA is a new, legal, advance consenting mechanism which, if implemented, grants planning permission for specified development.

Location of Possible Proposal for an MCA Scheme

Land at Essich Road, Inverness, IV2 6DJ, IV2 6AH and IV2 6AJ (see map on the next page).

Description of Possible Proposal for an MCA Scheme

Residential development of up to 400 houses (both affordable and private) with infrastructure, open space and landscaping.


How to Comment
