

**THE HIGHLAND COUNCIL  
PROPOSE TO CONSTRUCT SPEED CUSHIONS ON B9161 ARTAFALLIE –  
MUNLOCHY ROAD, MUNLOCHY**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that **The Highland Council**, in terms of the powers contained in section 36 and 37 of the **Roads (Scotland) Act 1984** as amended, **The Road Humps (Scotland) Regulations 1998** and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf propose to construct speed cushions on Artafallie - Munloch Road, Munloch, B9161, Munloch as follows:

- 25 metres or thereby south of the U2592 Munloch – Allangrange – Redfield, Munloch Junction, Inverness

The speed cushions are 70mm in height (max), 1750 mm wide and 1900 mm in length with approach ramp gradient of 1:10 and a side slope gradient of 1:10
