

## **THE HIGHLAND COUNCIL (B817, SALTBURN) (30mph Speed Limit) ORDER 2025**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that The Highland Council on the 9<sup>th</sup> February 2026 made, in terms of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the above Order which will come into operation on the 5<sup>th</sup> March 2026.

The Order was previously advertised by Notice in the Rosshire Journal on the 13<sup>th</sup> June 2025 and the effect of the Order is as described in that Notice.

Any person wishing to question the validity of the order or of any of its provisions on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the relevant enabling Act or that a requirement of any such enabling Act or of any relevant regulations made thereunder has not been complied with may, within 6 weeks from the date on which the order was made, make application for the purpose to the Court of Session.
