

## 15.0 Construction Design & Management

<u>The Construction (Design and Management) Regulations 2007</u>, often referred to as CDM, are important regulations in the construction industry in the United Kingdom introduced by the Health and Safety Executive's Construction Division. The regulations aim to improve safety in the construction industry, which employs over two million people in the UK.

## 15.1 The Highland Council's Policies

The Highland Council recognise the need to comply with The Construction (Design and Management) Regulations 2007 and to reduce the risks associated with construction work throughout the life cycle of a property.

A <u>Construction Design & Management Policy</u> has therefore been developed by The Highland Council to meet this need.

This policy must be read in conjunction with The Construction (Design & Management) Regulations 2007 and The Highland Council's <u>Management of Contractors Policy</u> and should both be adhered to fully.
