



This project represents a major investment in the Education and Community facilities for Wick.

The project began with the requirement to provide 'state of the art' secondary school facilities alongside a community hub including library, swimming pool and gym. This brief has been augmented by the development of the 3-18 model campus which aligns with the curriculum for excellence. The project sets a standard for stakeholder consultation and brief preparation which acts as an exemplar for forthcoming work.

Responding to the sometimes conflicting requirements of the brief, the design develops around internal 'streets' enlivened by dining, study and social spaces; and external courtyards which are sheltered social and educational spaces.

The design matches the school's aspirations for a seamless transition through 3-18, and as a community focus, well connected to the existing fabric of Wick.
