



The building takes advantage of the inspirational views and the visual connection with the city and the landscape beyond.

The classrooms have been arranged in two wings allowing the building to step down with the slope of the site.

Orientation of the teaching wings East to West ensures the building can make good use of the sun's path throughout the day with the ability for pupils to move to the decked areas immediately outside the classrooms.

The majority of the classrooms gain calm North light through full height glazed walls.

The building is composed of a simple palette of materials: metal, timber and glass.

The simple forms are influenced by the regional distinctiveness of agricultural buildings.
