



The new building provides a civic heart located within the established community village of Aviemore.

The facility is carefully positioned within the existing village and is designed to reflect the traditional forms of Highland Construction set within a modern context.

The external leaf base course is formed in locally sourced 'Alvie' stone. This is an echo of the traditional croft 'Cruck' frame which used a stone base wall and the turf and plaster infill above which has been replaced with a more contemporary high insulation rain screen to framed timber walls formed in (Scot-larch ) from a local supply source.

The new facility aims to support people who work in and enjoy the area as a work base and permanent home.
