The proposal was developed around the original stone school hall to provide a new Primary School and Fire Station. The primary school and nursery operates on one level with easy access to level playground areas. The Fire Station is formed within the under-croft to the Primary School with internal access to allow shared facilities.

- phasing of building programme round a live school
- integrating existing key structures
- community involvement
