IMPORTANT INFORMATION AND GUIDANCE ON DISPLAY NOTICES UNDER THE LICENSING (SCOTLAND) ACT 2005

The following notes are a brief outline of the requirements for displaying Notices under the above Act. They should be treated as **guidelines only and not an authoritative statement of law. Advice should be sought from your Solicitor as to your legal rights and obligations.** It is important that you acquaint yourself with the law and read the conditions attached to your Premises Licence. Further guidance can be sought from your local Licensing Standards Officer.

As a premises licence holder you are required to display the following mandatory information:

- 1. **A Summary of your premises licence** (this will be issued with your premises licence) This must be prominently displayed where it may be read by persons frequenting the premises.
- Schedule 3 Admission of under 18s (On Sale Premises only) This must be visible to customers entering the premises and must be at least A4 size. The wording will vary according to your premises licence but must state-
 - A) that persons under 18 are not permitted on the premises; or
 - B) that persons under 18 are permitted on the premises or on such part of the premises as are specified on the sign.

3) Section 110 Notice

This is down loadable from our website at <u>www.highland.gov.uk/businessinformation/licensing/liquorlicensing</u> this must be displayed at all times at the point of sale and be readily visible to any person seeking to buy alcohol.

It is an offence not to display these notices.
