ITINERANT METAL DEALER'S LICENCE: SCHEDULE OF CONDITIONS

- 1. Any change of address(es) of the licence holder must be notified to the licensing authority before or as soon as reasonably practicable after the change of address(es) has taken place.
- 2. The licence holder shall carry on his business only on the following days of the week [as per current licence conditions]

and between the following hours each day -

- 3. The licence holder shall comply with all legislative provisions affecting his trade and in particular all relevant provisions of the Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982 and any orders made thereunder
- 4. Where the licence holder is a tenant of, or resides in, a local authority dwellinghouse, no metal dealing business shall be carried out from the place of residence without the written consent of the Council.
- 5. No metal should be kept or stored in the house or grounds of the licence holder.
