## How to Work Out Your New Pay

Here are some examples:

A full time employee (standard working hours 35 hrs ) on grade HC3, spinal point 10.

| Hourly Rate | $=35$ hours $\times 52$ weeks | $=£ 8.08$ |

| Annual Hours worked | $=1820$ hours $\times £ 8.08$ | $=£ 14,706$ |

A full time employee (standard working hours 37 hrs ) on grade HC2, spinal point 6.

| Hourly Rate | $=37$ hours $\times 52$ weeks | $=£ 7.16$ |

| Annual Hours worked | $=1924$ hours $\times £ 7.16$ | $=£ 13,776$ |
| Basic Annual Salary |  | $=£ \mathbf{1 3 , 7 7 6}$ |

A part time employee (17.5 hrs per week) on grade HC3, spinal point 10.

| Hourly Rate | $=17.5$ hours $\times 52$ weeks | $=£ 8108$ |
| :--- | :--- | :--- |
| Annual Hours worked | $=910$ hours $\times £ 8.08$ | $=£ 7,353$ |
| Basic Annual Salary |  | $=£ 7,353$ |
