The Wick Campus

Stage 1 - Council response

The Council has accepted the Hub's Stage 1 Submission – with a Maximum Predicted Price for the High School and Community Facilities of £27.2M.

New Project Request (NPR) - Campus Primary

Hub have now accepted the NPR for the Campus Primary, at a maximum cost of £11.474M.

Planning:

A formal Planning Application for the whole Campus site (The Primary School, High School and Community Facilities) was submitted by GMA Ryder, the Hub's architects, on Friday 14th June 2013.

The Pre Planning Meeting took place on 29th April in the Assembly Rooms.

A presentation was made at the recent Stakeholder Meeting (Monday 17th June) on the results of this consultation.

Positive Comments

- Happy with floor plan and landscape layout
- Happy with overall appearance and scale of the building
- Single storey building welcome

Wick North of the River Primary (cont.)

Concerns

- Drop off provision at Girnigoe Street
- Introduction of one way systems for traffic and enhanced safety measures
- Safe Routes and crossing points for pedestrians
- Provision of cycle lanes / routes
- Extent of 20mph speed limit
- Security in courtyard areas

Next Steps (to address above)

- Progress with Safe Routes to School Consultation continues
- Liaison with Council TECs Services on raid safety issues
- Continued collaboration between Council and Hubco architects

Planning

It is intended that a full Planning Application for this school will be submitted by Hubco architects in late August / early September.

Stakeholder Meeting – 17th June 2013

The approach to the naming of the new schools was discussed. Suggestions will be sought from pupils and members of the public. There is a commitment to involve pupils in reviewing the suggestions. The Head Teachers will draw up proposals for this process.

Miller Construction gave an update on opportunities for local contractors in the construction process. The work is currently being divided in the work packages for specific trades. Local contractors will be matched to the work packages and given an opportunity to tender, provided they meet Miller's prequalification requirements.

Stakeholder Meeting – 17th June 2013 (cont)

The process of identifying new uses for the buildings to be vacated is underway.

A communication strategy was agreed, with specific actions and responsibilities to ensure that everyone in the area is kept up to date with the progress of the project. Design updates will be added to the Council website as the project progresses.
