Several traditional staging posts within the remote and sparsely populated interior continue to offer lifeline services in remote, fragile communities. Prospects are dependent on sustained employment in estate/land management, tourism and interpretive facilities and local enterprise. Development pressures are negligible. Given a lack of first-time infrastructure, a flexible development regime needs to balance safeguards for the existing character and environmental standards.

What heritage or amenity features should be better used, protected or enhanced?
