## **Prospects**

Pittentrail is a small village in the parish of Rogart, sustaining important local facilities, including a shop, hall and rail halt.

The former auction mart offers scope for redevelopment. The site is in the centre of the village and is a prime location for a mix of housing, business and community uses.

Another allocation for housing is opposite the garage. This site is also close to the centre of the village.

In addition the area around MacDonald Place is within a settlement development area which will allow scope for some development within that boundary. No specific sites have been allocated here, however a variety of house types and styles would be welcomed.

## **Development Factors**

- Low downward emission design street lights;
- Developments require connection to public sewerage system.
