Declaration of Result

I declare that the result of the election in the Black Isle Ward is as follows:

There is 1 councillor to be elected.

The percentage poll was 35.81%. There were 3,061 valid papers and 23 rejected papers.

The quota of votes for a candidate to be elected is 1,531.

The votes received by each of the candidates and this final stage at which the candidate was elected is as follows:
