NOTICE: REQUEST FOR FURTHER INFORMATION**

I am writing regarding the Sutherland Local Plan which was submitted to DPEA on the 24 July 2009 for examination by Scottish Ministers. Under Regulation 22 of the Town and Country Planning (Development Planning) (Scotland) Regulations 2008 the appointed reporter can request, by way of notice, further information in connection with the examination. This letter is a notice under Regulation 22.

The following additional information is requested by the reporters in relation to the following:-

Issue No: 74 – Tongue – MU1 West of the Manse

The submissions refer to a number of buildings – the steadings of the Old Manse, the Old Manse and the adjacent Church. Please confirm whether any of these buildings are listed, along with the details of any listing.

Issue No: 80 – Bettyhill – H1 West of the School, H2 West of Munro Place

It has been noted that some works have commenced on these sites, please clarify the Council's current planning status.

Issue No: 53 – MU1 Former Hotel/outbuildings

It has been noted that some works have commenced on this site, please clarify the Council's current planning status and any relationship this may have to the H1 allocation – South West of Main Street.

It would be helpful if you could send this information to me, to pass on to the reporter, by 1 October 2009.

I hope this is in order and shall be obliged if you could kindly acknowledge receipt of this letter and confirm when it has been posted on the Council's website.
