<p>Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 Section 14</p>	<p>SCHEDULE OF CHARGES FOR TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURES</p> <p>Temporary Traffic Regulation Order £1493</p> <p>Any Extension to the Order £556</p> <p>Inspection charge per week or part thereof £110</p> <p>Note:- the above charges include the cost of advertising and apply to a) contractors carrying out road works etc. and b) utilities and their contractors carrying out roadworks etc.</p> <p>The responsibility for the implementation of the Temporary Road Closure lies with the individual Contractors or Public Utility. The Council may carryout the implementation on the basis of full cost recovery.</p>

<p>Roads (Scotland) Act 1984 Section 90(1)</p>	<p>ERECTION OF BANNERS</p> <p>£203 for erection and removal of banner plus £19 per week for duration.</p> <p>No charge for registered charities and events with a community, social or economic benefit to the local area. Ward Manager approval may be required prior to issuing consent.</p>
<p>Roads (Scotland) Act 1984 Section 59(1)</p>	<p>STREET CAFES</p> <p>Initial administration fee of £185 plus an annual charge of £27 per square metre of occupation.</p> <p>It will be a condition of consent that applicants enter into a formal agreement covering the conditions of placement and use with particular emphasis on access for purposes of roads maintenance and public utility works.</p>
<p>Roads (Scotland) Act 1984 Section 59(1)</p>	<p>MARKETS AND STALLS</p> <p>Initial administration fee of £91 plus an annual charge of £9 per square metre of occupation for regularly recurring events.</p> <p>Initial administration fee of £91 plus a charge of £7 per square metre of occupation for one-off events.</p> <p>Where promotion of a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order is required the costs for this, as specified above, will also be payable.</p>
