

ROADS (SCOTLAND) ACT 1984

THE HIGHLAND COUNCIL (DOUGLAS ROW AND HUNTLY STREET, INVERNESS)(REDETERMINATION OF MEANS OF EXERCISE OF PUBLIC RIGHT OF PASSAGE) ORDER 2012

The Highland Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by S 152(2) of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984 and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf hereby make the following order.

- This order may be cited as "The Highland Council (Douglas Row and Huntly Street, Inverness) (Redetermination of Means of Exercise of Public Right of Passage) Order 2012" and shall come into operation on ***
- The lengths of road in the area specified in the Schedule to this Order, at present footway shall become cycle track the right of passage being exercisable on pedal cycle and foot only

Schedule

LENGTHS OF ROAD OVER WHICH MEANS OF EXERCISE OF PUBLIC RIGHT OF PASSAGE ARE TO BE REDETERMINED AS CYCLE TRACK

Huntly Street

The footway on the northeast side of Huntly Street from its conjunction with Friars Place southeastwards to its junction with Young Street

Douglas Row

The footway on the southwest side of Douglas Row from its junction with Glebe Street southeastwards to its junction with Bank Street

Which said lengths of footway shall become cycle track for use of pedal cycle and foot only all as the said lengths of road are shown in sawtooth hatching on the plan annexed and signed as relative hereto.
