#### **Extensions and Improvements to Cemeteries**

#### Report by Acting Head of Roads and Community Works

#### Summary

This report invites Members to approve the updated 10 year programme for cemetery extensions and replacements.

#### 1. Background

- 1.1 In a previous report presented to TECS committee on 14 March 2013 (TEC-26-13), Members approved a 10 year cemetery extension / replacement to be included in the Council's Capital Programme.
- 1.2 This report provides an update on the programme together with details of progress.
- 1.3 The Highland Council is responsible for the maintenance of 257 cemeteries. This figure includes 84 cemeteries which have been closed for burials, however the Council is still responsible for maintaining the grounds.

#### 2. Current Position

- 2.1 From the current assessment of cemetery capacity there are 27 cemeteries identified, an increase of 4 since 2013, as requiring extensions and /or replacements within the next 10 years, these are listed in **Appendix A**.
- 2.2 Work to provide an extension or a new cemetery is currently underway for 13 of the 27 cemeteries listed in **Appendix A**.
- 2.3 Large scale extension works at 4 cemeteries, Morefield (Ullapool), Nairn, Tain and Acharacle will be completed within the next 12 months.
- 2.4 17 cemeteries have been identified with between 10 and 15 years capacity and these are listed in **Appendix B**.
- 2.5 Although there are sufficient lairs available to meet current demand, advance selling of lairs has been stopped at has been stopped at a number of cemeteries (in accordance with the Council's "Management Rules for Cemeteries"), to protect capacity for future burials.

#### 3. 10 Year Programme of Cemetery Extensions / Replacements

- 3.1 A programme has been produced showing when extensions and/or replacements will be provided for the 27 cemeteries in **Appendix A**.
- 3.2 The programme of extensions or replacements of cemeteries has been developed to spread works over several years with Area teams delivering works where practicable.
- 3.2 The Councils Capital Programme provides a general capital allocation of £100k per annum for the extension or replacement of cemeteries from 2014/15 to 2017/18. Works are programmed at Arisaig, Alness, Fodderty, Skeabost, Chaplehill, Clachan, Canisbay, Reay, Glen Nevis and St Mary's (Beauly) cemeteries in 2014/15.
- 3.3 For extension or replacement of large cemeteries the Capital Programme also includes a capital allocation £500k in 2016/17 and 2017/18.
- 3.4 The capacities of cemeteries in **Appendix B** will be kept under review and the cemeteries which fall below a 10 year capacity will be taken for inclusion in the Council's Capital Programme
- 3.5 The cemetery extension programme will be reviewed annually to ensure that the time periods are accurate and that updated cost estimates are fed into the Capital Programme.

#### 4. Implications

- 4.1 The cost will be accommodated in the Council's Capital Programme.
- 4.2 There are no legal implications arising from this report.
