Summary

Ref: HC/RSL/1632 **Premises:** Talisker Distillery (Mash House), Carbost, Isle of Skye, IV47 8SR **Licence Holder:** Diageo Scotland Limited

Section 28 of the Licensing (Scotland) Act 2005: The Licensed Premises in respect of which the licence was issued has ceased to be used for the sale of alcohol.

1.0 Background

Talisker Distillery is a working distillery in Carbost on the Isle of Skye. The premises underwent refurbishment from October 2012 to end of March 2013 and the Temporary Premises Licence for the Mash House was granted by the Board on 25 September 2012 to allow trading to continue during the refurbishment works.

2.0 Surrender of Premises Licence

The Premises Licence Holder notified the Board on 9 April 2013 that as the refurbishment works were complete, the Temporary Licence was no longer required and they wished to surrender it.

The Board is invited to note that the Temporary Premises Licence has been surrendered and has ceased to have effect.
