Capital Projects Funded by Inverness Common Good Fund

1 General

1.1 This appendix provides project status information for current key capital projects funded by the Inverness Common Good Fund, including financial progress details, as at 22 November 2013.

2 Capital Programme Update

2.1 The current status of each individual project is summarised below.

2.2 Restoration of Inverness Steeple

- 2.2.1 The contract was completed on the 22 March 2013 and the defects liability period will end on the 21 March 2014.
- 2.2.2 The final account has been agreed.

Agreed Budget £550,000 Final Account £520,000

2.3 Replacement of Gas Boilers; Inverness Town House

- 2.3.1 The contract was completed on the 4 October 2013 and the defects liability period will end on the 3 October 2014. The over spend is due to the existing gas main to the kitchen being upgraded.
- 2.3.2 The final account has been agreed.

Agreed Budget £225,000 Agreed Final Account £226,147

2.4 Conservation of External Fabric, Town House, Inverness

2.4.1 A Members briefing is to be organised to update Members on the Project prior to reporting to the next available Committee.

2.5 Replacement of High Level Windows, Market Arcade, Victorian Market

2.5.1 Tenders have been received and the lowest tender is above the budget estimate. The lowest tender is £80,407.67. The tender figure is over budget because the work was agreed to be undertaken out with opening hours of the Market. This is a better option to avoid any effect on the businesses and the general public. The committee is asked to agree the increase in budget.

Agreed Budget £70,000

2.6 Internal Re-painting, Market Arcade, Victorian Market

2.6.1 Listed Building Application has been submitted. It is anticipated that the work will commence Jan 2014 and be completed by Feb 2014. This project is to be funded from the Victorian maintenance budget.

Agreed Budget £10,000

2.7 Refurbishment 1-5 Church Street, Inverness

- 2.7.1 Project currently on programme.
- 2.7.2 The programme in place is as follows;

2.8 Victorian Market – Installation of Photovoltaic Panels

- 2.8.1 An instruction was given to investigate the possibility of PV panels being installed on the roof of the Victorian Market. A feasibility study was carried out and this came to the conclusion it was a viable option.
- 2.8.2 Tenders were invited and the lowest cost is £20,445.95 including fees. The estimated payback analysis is calculated over a 25 year period. The payback period is 8 years. It is anticipated that the total feed in tariff will be £28,461.45 and the total electricity saved will be in the region £28,026.76 over the 25 year period.

3. Governance

3.1 These projects are funded by the Inverness Common Good Fund and monthly Contract Monitoring reports will be issued to the Inverness City Manager, in line with governance arrangements.
