Response to Mrs M Davidson

Highland leads in terms of community owned assets with 22.4% of the Scottish total.

The Council has had a policy in place to deal with Community Asset Transfer Requests at below market value since June 2012. It includes:

- Communities expressing interest in the transfer (through ownership/lease) of Council owned vacant and surplus land and property are invited to prepare a business case to support their proposals, and to demonstrate that their proposals are viable and sustainable as well as how their proposals support the Council's Aims and Objectives.
- 2. Community interests in Council property asset transfer are either sponsored by the outgoing occupying Service (if that Service has an interest in supporting a particular community proposal) or, if not, by the relevant Ward Manager in developing and bringing forward their business case.

I have passed Mrs Davidson additional detailed information on the operation of this policy and also information on all the disposals of Council property to community groups since 1st April 2010. I am happy to make this information available to other Members.
