Capital Projects Funded by Inverness Common Good Fund

1 General

1.1 This appendix provides project status information for current key capital projects funded by the Inverness Common Good Fund, including financial progress details, as at 17 February 2014.

2 Capital Programme Update

2.1 The current status of each individual project is summarised below.

2.2 Restoration of Inverness Steeple

- 2.2.1 The contract was completed on the 22 March 2013 and the defects liability period will end on the 21 March 2014.
- 2.2.2 The final account has been agreed.

Agreed Budget £550,000 Final Account £520,000

2.3 Replacement of Gas Boilers; Inverness Town House

- 2.3.1 The contract was completed on the 4 October 2013 and the defects liability period will end on the 3 October 2014.
- 2.3.2 The final account has been agreed.

Agreed Budget £225,000 Agreed Final Account £226,147

2.4 Replacement of High Level Windows, Market Arcade, Victorian Market

2.4.1 The windows have been ordered with delivery on Friday 21st February 2014. The contractor has been mobilised and ready to start April 2014. It is anticipated the work will be completed June 2014. All work will be undertaken after 6:00pm.

Agreed Budget £80,000

2.5 Internal Re-painting, Market Arcade, Victorian Market

2.5.1 Listed Building Application has been approved. It is anticipated that the work will commence w/c 10th March 2014 and be completed early April 2014. The work will be carried out after 6:00pm. This project is to be funded from the Victorian maintenance budget.

2.7 Refurbishment 1-5 Church Street, Inverness
