5i	AED Defibrillators	The aim of the Scottish Ambulance Service is to have public access to defibrillators in the whole of Scotland. They must be readily available and placed on outside walls and not locked away in cupboards. The cost per machine is £3000 - £5000, however if they are supplied via the British Heart Foundation the cost drops to approx. £1200 per machine (NB the BHF has set criteria which must be satisfied re electricity supply, regular checks etc.). Ideally they should be placed strategically so that access is always nearby. Potential Inverness locations mentioned include; Council Service Point, High Street, Eastgate, The Bus Station, Train Station, Culloden, Kinmylies etc. Individual Partners offered to contact relevant organisations;
