Free School Meals P1-3 Update

Report by Director or Care and Learning

Summary

This report provides an update on progress with implementation of free school meals for Primary 1 to 3 pupils, effective from January 2015.

1. Background

- 1.1 The Scottish Government policy for free school meals for Primary 1 to 3 pupils is to be implemented from January 2015.
- 1.2 Previous reports to Committee have highlighted that in the vast majority of the Council's schools, the policy can be implemented in a relatively straightforward manner, with additional resources put in place to support i.e. additional supervision and cleaning arrangements; additional serving points; and additional catering equipment. Based on the latest school rolls and estimated meals uptake, there are 35 schools where the consequences of the policy are more significant, in terms of uptake of meals and capacity within the kitchen and dining space. In these cases, some amendments to arrangements within the school, and in some cases the need for capital investment to support delivering the policy, will be required.
- 1.3 The Council's planning assumptions are based upon 90% of those entitled under the policy, taking free school meals. This high level of uptake takes account of the Council's success in having a high level of school meal uptake at present, and outcomes from trials in other Councils which gave indications of the potential impact across P1-3 pupils. It is estimated that in total, the additional number of meals to be served will represent an average increase of 37% across all Highland schools.
- 1.4 As previously reported to Committee, the Council has been notified of additional revenue funding from Scottish Government to support implementation of £0.793m 2014/15 rising to £2.595m in 2015/16.
- 1.5 In relation to capital, Scottish Government funding is also to be made available, and the Council through CoSLA has submitted its case for capital investment required. It is estimated the Council's costs may be up to £5m. It is expected that final decisions on distribution of funding to Councils may be taken by the end of November.

2. Implementation Progress

2.1 Good progress has been made since the report to the August Committee. The site by site options assessment and feasibility has now concluded in all but 17 schools. This is due to time restraints and as consequence of the re-evaluation of additional schools based on updated school roll data. As a result, the implementation arrangements for

the majority have now been agreed at a local level with Head Teachers and Catering Staff, and arrangements are being progressed for January 2015 implementation.

- 2.2 **Appendix 1** provides information on the types of arrangement which will be put in place for January 2015. Only those 35 sites where some change in delivery arrangements is planned are shown i.e. additional sittings, re-location of packed lunch pupils, extension of the lunch break duration, introduction of secondary service point, re-arrangement of sittings, additional or replacement of cooking equipment, and additional preparation areas. In many sites, there is no significant change in arrangements; hence these are not listed (i.e. the impact is small or incidental and where additional catering staff may be the only change that has had to be put in place).
- 2.3 As highlighted at the previous Committee, the Council has 11 schools with no current school meals provision, due to financial and practical constraints a list is provided in **Appendix 1**. Historically, the arrangements at these locations for entitled families are that they are paid the economic daily rate for when the pupils are in attendance, in lieu of a meal. It is intended that this existing arrangement will continue at these locations from January 2015. If practical or financially viable alternatives become available in the future, then this arrangement could be reviewed. The number of pupils expected to be covered by this arrangement is expected to increase from 11 under the existing free school meals entitlement, to an estimated 47 from January 2015.
- 2.4 In relation to additional staffing across Highland Schools, it is estimated that an additional staffing resource in excess of 20 FTE will be required. 46 new posts have been advertised, and there will be an extension to the hours of existing staff. Recruitment to the new posts will be taking place over November and December, so that the new arrangements can commence from January.
- 2.5 In relation to additional items of equipment and furniture, orders are being placed at present for delivery in time for January.
- 2.6 A communication strategy is being developed, to ensure that all stakeholders are informed of the new arrangements and entitlements well before January 2015. A consultative group has been set up involving head teachers, cooks, catering officers, children's dietician, members of the management team and representatives from early learning and childcare. This group will be used to inform and discuss progress and actions of the free school meals P1-P3 project. As previously advised to Committee, the existing clothing grant/free school meal entitlement scheme and application process will remain in place, due to the need to still have a process in place for clothing grants applications.
- 2.7 For those sites requiring more significant capital investment, work is ongoing to assess options and solutions, and it has always been the case these arrangements would take longer to implement. Where appropriate, interim arrangements are being put in place until such time as the capital solutions are in place. In progressing capital options, opportunities will be taken to ensure that requirements are considered in a cohesive manner, taking account of any other prioritised needs within the school that could be considered at the same time i.e. solutions to increase dining and kitchen capacity, may also factor in other demand areas such as nursery, ASN, PE or other requirements. This is of course subject to available Council resources, as capital funding from the Scottish Government is only for the direct impact of free school meals.

3. Implications

- 3.1 **Resource implications** additional revenue funding has been made available from Scottish Government, and at this time it is expected this will be sufficient to meet the revenue costs of implementation. This position will be kept under review as the actual level of uptake, and any knock on effect on older siblings taking meals and pupils as they progress beyond P1-3 will only be known over time. As highlighted within this report, the equivalent of an additional 20+ FTE staffing will be put in place and funded from Scottish Government funds. In relation to capital, no significant commitments relating to building works will be made until capital funding is notified and further discussions and decisions take place. Only essential equipment and furniture orders are being placed at this time.
- 3.2 **Legal/Equalities/Rural implications** as highlighted at paragraph 2.3, there will remain a small number of schools and pupils (mainly very rural and island schools) where existing arrangements to provide payment to parents in lieu of a meal will continue, where financial and practical constraints limit putting in place provision of meals. Scottish Government officials are aware of this existing arrangement through recent discussions on free school meals P1-3 implementation.
- 3.3 Climate Change/Carbon Clever implications the increased number of meal servings may have a negative impact due to increased cooking, heating and resulting use of energy supplies. However, there is scope for mitigation whereby new cooking equipment, and any capital building/alterations, may provide scope to improve energy efficiency in particular locations.
- 3.4 **Risk implications** there is a risk that some items of heavy equipment may not be in place by January 15, for example due to practical constraints on when such items can be delivered and installed. In such a scenario work around arrangements will be possible in the short-term but may require interim changes to serving arrangements, sittings, serving times, etc.
- 3.5 **Gaelic implications** the policy will be implemented across Highland schools, including those that are Gaelic medium.

4. Recommendation

4.1 Members are asked to note progress in relation to implementation of free school meals for Primary 1 to 3 pupils from January 2015.
