# Application for the Grant of a Taxi Driver's Licence – Jena Robyn McLean Report by the Legal Manager

# **Summary**

This Report relates to an application for the grant of a taxi driver's licence.

This item is subject to a formal hearing procedure.

# 1.0 Background

1.1 The Highland Council has resolved that in terms of the Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982 a licence will be required for the driving of a licensed taxi. A licence for the same is issued by the Highland Council and is valid for the whole Council Area.

# 2.0 Application

2.1 On 7 July 2014 an application for the grant of a taxi driver's licence was received from Jena R McLean, 20 Castle Terrace, Thurso.

## 3.0 Process

- **3.1** Following receipt of the application a copy of the same was circulated to the following Agencies/Services for consultation:
  - Police Scotland
  - Highland Council Trading Standards Service
- 3.2 No representations were received in respect of the application.

## 4.0 Taxi Driver's Knowledge Test

As part of the application process all applicants for taxi driver's licences must pass a knowledge test. The knowledge test consists of two sections and the applicant must pass both sections. The first section is a multiple choice paper on general knowledge in relation to highway code, landmarks etc in Highland and shortest routes between 2 locations in Highland. The second section consists of a written test in relation to the local Caithness area and includes questions on shortest routes between 2 locations within that area and the locations of local landmarks etc. Applicants are permitted to sit three attempts at the knowledge test.

4.2 Ms McLean has sat one set of test papers and has failed these. She received 64% on the general knowledge section and 44% on the local section. The pass mark is 85%. She has been offered to sit the permitted two further attempts prior to the Committee meeting.

### 5.0 **Determination of Application**

5.1 Under Section 3(1) of the Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982 the application requires to be determined within six months, ie 7 January 2015.
