SHARED HIGHLANDS APPRENTICESHIP COMPANY LTD

Summary

Shared Highlands Apprenticeship Company Ltd has requested that the Chair of the Planning, Development and Infrastructure Committee become a member of their Board. This report recommends that this be approved.

1. Background

- 1.1 The Shared Apprenticeship Scheme (SAS) was launched, in Inverness, on 18 May 2015. Shared Highlands Apprenticeship Company Ltd (SHAC) is the company responsible for running the Scheme throughout the Highlands.
- 1.2 SHAC Ltd directly employees the apprentices and engages with supply chain companies to identify placement opportunities. The project provides young people with the opportunity to work in the construction industry and obtain a full modern apprenticeship qualification, supports local building contractors, and tackles the growing shortage of skilled construction workers in the Highlands.
- 1.3 The Highland Council part-funded the set up costs of SHAC, and members are advised that SHAC Ltd have requested the Chair of the Planning, Development and Infrastructure committee becomes a member of their board.
