Street naming – Developments in Fortrose and North Kessock

Report by Head of Policy and Reform

Summary

The Area Committee is asked to homologate the naming of roads for Phase D of the Fortrose, Ness Road Housing Development, as Cornwell Crescent and North Kessock, Phase 6, land at Bellfield and Lettoch Farm as Yairs Rise.

1. Background

- 1.1 The Council's Corporate Address Gazetteer (CAG) Team within the Planning and Development Service was asked to create addresses by the developers for
 - i. twenty four new houses in phase D, Ness Road Housing development, Fortrose.
 - ii. twenty one new houses in Phase 6, land at Bellfield and Lettoch Farm, North Kessock

No suggestions were put forward by the respective developers.

2. Consultations

- 2.1 A request was sent to the Ward Manager to consult with the Community Council and Local Members.
- 2.2 i. Fortrose Community Council put forward the name Cornwell Crescent
 - ii. Knockbain Community Council put forward the name Yairs Rise

After consultation with Local Members the majority of Members supported the proposed names put forward by the Community Councils

- 2.3 The Ward Business Meeting therefore approved:
 - i. Cornwell Crescent, Fortrose
 - ii. Yairs Rise, North Kessock

3. Delegation to Area Committee

3.1 As per the Scheme of Delegation the final decision on Street and Building Naming is delegated to the Area/City Committees. However, as the properties were nearing completion the naming requests were considered a matter of urgency and were brought before Ward Members, resulting in this report coming to the Area Committee for homologation.
