Capital Expenditure – Final Outturn 2014/15 and Monitoring 2015/16

Report by Director of Community Services

Summary

This report invites Members to approve the capital expenditure outturn position for the year ended 31 March 2015, and the monitoring position for the period 1 April 2015 to 30 June 2015.

1. Background

1.1 This report is produced in support of the Council's corporate governance process, which in turn is designed to support/augment the Council's overall/corporate delivery of all of its obligations in terms of the Single Outcome Agreement.

2. Final Outturn 2014/15

2.1 The summary of capital expenditure against current programme and final outturn is included in **Appendix A**. The "Budget" column is that approved by the Highland Council on 27 June 2013, amended to include the 2013/14 underspend of £2.511m.

3. Expenditure

- 3.1 At financial year end the gross expenditure was £10.252m representing 79.3% of the 2014/15 programmed figure.
- 3.2 The underspend is mainly due to planned slippage in the replacement of vehicle and plant purchases, delays in purchasing land for the new burial ground extension in Nairn, weather delays on road structural works and delays in the awarding of contracts.

4. Income

- 4.1 The actual income received was £1.267m representing 236.8% of the 2014/15 projected outturn figure.
- 4.2 The increase in income relates to developers contributions towards road structural works, grant funding from the Scottish Timber Transport Fund, and the sale of vehicles and plant.

5. Summary Position

- 5.1 The final outturns for expenditure and income are £10.252m and £1.267m respectively leading to an underspend of £3.416m.
- 5.2 A projected underspend of £2.155m was reported to the Community Services Committee on 5 February 2015. The increased underspend is as a result of the developers contributions and grant funding (4.2 above refers), underspends on structural road works due to weather delays and contractual delays.
- 5.3 Budgets for projects not started or partially completed have been carried forward to the 2015/16 programme.

6. Housing Revenue Account (HRA) – Final Outturn 2014/15

- 6.1 The HRA capital programme reflects the Council's commitment to meet the Scottish Housing Quality Standard (SHQS), to ensure that properties are adapted to meet the changing needs of tenants, and the Council house building programme.
- 6.2 The capital programme summary is included in **Appendix B**. It shows expenditure to 31 March 2015 was £43.241m of which £19.826m relates to mainstream HRA capital programme expenditure, £22.517m relates to Council house building, and £0.898m relates to new build through the temporary accommodation reprovisioning project.
- 6.3 The final outturn was £8.293m underspent. The underspend comprises overspends of £3.523m on new build and £0.898m on the new build for one-bed accommodation and an underspend on the main programme of £12.714m. The overspend in the Council house building element is due to projects progressing in advance of previously predicted timetables. The underspend on SHQS element of the programme is mainly due to slippage and delays in awarding heating contracts.
- 6.4 The overall HRA capital programme for 2014/15 was partly funded from HRA capital receipts of £1.816m, and capital from current revenue of £4.198m, as well as grant income and landbank funding of £12.413m. The remainder of funding was through new borrowing of £24.814m, of which £13.812m related to mainstream programme and £10.104m related to Council house building. £0.898m for new one-bed accommodation was funded from revenue savings on temporary accommodation.

7. Capital Expenditure Monitoring (1 April 2015 to 30 June 2015)

7.1 The summary of capital expenditure against current programme and estimated outturn is included in **Appendix C**. The "Budget" column is that approved by the Highland Council on 12 March 2015, amended to include the 2014/15 underspend of £3.416m.

8. Expenditure

8.1 After 3 months of the financial year end the gross expenditure is £1.041m representing 6.7% of the 2015/16 programmed figure.

9. Income

9.1 After 3 months of the financial year the gross income is £0.121m representing 39.9% of the 2015/16 programmed figure.

10. Progress on Capital Projects

10.1 Progress on capital projects is as reported in the notes column on **Appendix C**.

11. Estimated Outturn

11.1 The projected outturns for expenditure and income are £15.534m and £0.303m respectively leading to a balanced programme.

12. Major Issues and Variances

12.1 At present there are no major issues or variances.

13. HRA Capital Programme 2015-16

- 13.1 The mainstream HRA Capital Programme 2013/15 was approved by the Finance, Housing and Resources (FHR) Committee on 3 October 2012, subsequently updated for revised cost estimates, and approved by the FHR Committee on 9 October 2013 and Community Services Committee on 5 February 2015. Allowing for the underspend in 2014/15 the remaining budget to fund SHQS work, adaptations, and other improvements to existing housing is £44.825m. The mainstream HRA capital budget for 2015/16 is £44.825m.
- 13.2 The Council house building programme was approved by the FHR Committee on 30 January 2013, and further amended at the Highland Council meeting on 7 March 2013, giving an overall target of 688 new Council houses by 2017. The total programme cost is estimated to be of the order of £92m. To allow progression and continuation of the programme, the Council house building element of the HRA capital programme for 2015/16 is £19.701m.

14. Net Expenditure

14.1 After 3 months of the financial year end the net expenditure is £5.089m representing 7.8% of the 2015/16 programmed figure.

15. **Progress on Programme**

15.1 Progress on capital projects is as reported in the notes column on **Appendix D**.

16. Estimated Outturn

16.1 The projected outturn for net expenditure is £65.026m leading to a balanced programme.

17. Major Issues and Variances

17.1 The target for completion on-site of the SHQS work remains for completion by the end of the calendar year. The extent of work required makes the target challenging, and progress will continue to be reported to each Committee.

18. Implications

- 18.1 Resource implications are discussed in the report.
- 18.2 There is a risk on delivery of the SHQS work within the target date of December 2015.
- 18.3 There are no legal, equalities, climate change/carbon clever, Gaelic and rural implications arising as a direct result of this report.

19. **Recommendations**

- 19.1 Members are invited to approve the capital expenditure outturn position for the year ended 31 March 2015.
- 19.2 Members are invited to approve the capital expenditure monitoring position for the period 1 April 2015 to 30 June 2015.
