Capital Projects – Investing in Caithness and Sutherland

Report by Director of Finance

Summary

The report lists the capital projects included in the Council's capital programme being delivered in the Caithness and Sutherland area in financial year 2015/16 and the inyear budgets for these projects.

1. Background

- 1.1 This report shows, subtotalled by Council Service, the capital projects being delivered in the Caithness and Sutherland area.
- 1.2 This report is presented annually to inform Members of the planned capital projects in the Caithness and Sutherland area. Supporting reports on specific projects can be available from the appropriate Service for future area meetings as required.

2. Overview

- 2.1 Appendix 1 lists an expanded project title and the 2015/16 budget for each project. The report is not designed to update on project progress. Should this be required, information will be provided to the next Committee meeting or to Ward Business Meetings as appropriate.
- 2.2 The projects included in Appendix 1 are those which are specific to the Caithness and Sutherland area. Other capital jobs are being undertaken within the area as part of generic Council-wide capital projects; such expenditure is not included in this report.
- 2.3 Ward Business Meetings are regularly provided with information on the Community Services programme of works which details the planned work being delivered in the Caithness and Sutherland area from the Roads Structural Capital Works budget.
