Description: Re-development of the existing Cairngorm Mountain Ski Resort base

station buildings.

1.0 BACKGROUND

- 1.1 To inform the Planning Applications Committee of the submission of the attached Proposal of Application Notice (PAN).

2.0 DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED DEVELOPMENT

- 2.1 The proposal involves re-development of the existing Cairngorm Mountain Ski Resort base-station buildings, that is intended to increase the level of current leisure and sport offering, in addition to enhancing the quality and variety of the guest experience all year round.
- 2.2 This will take the form of a substantial extension to the existing Cairngorm Mountain Ski Resort base station buildings and demolition of the existing Day Lodge building. The building gross floor space would be in the region of 6,400m².

3.0 SITE DESCRIPTION

The site is the existing Cairngorm Mountain Ski Resort base-station buildings and car-park area located within the Coire Cas.
