#### **Purpose/Executive Summary**

1.1 This report is to advise Members on proposed speed restrictions for part of the B849 Drimnin Road.

#### 2 Recommendations

2.1 Members are invited to approve the introduction of a 30mph speed restrictions on part of the B849 Lochaline - Drimnin Road, and to approve the preparation and advertising of a Draft Order and location plan (available at **Appendix 1 and 2**) and the making of the Order should there be no unresolved objection.

## 3 Background

- 3.1 A request was made in July 2016 by the local Police Office, on behalf of West Ardnamurchan Community Council for a speed limit at the end of the B849 Lochaline -Drimnin Road.
- 3.2 As a result of this request a speed survey was carried out. This result of this showed a mean speed of traffic of 30mph.

### 4 Response

4.1 The results of the traffic survey are satisfactory for the implementation of a 30mph speed limit in this vicinity. These proposals have been developed after full liaison with the Community Council to improve the general safety of all road users.
