Proposed silt storage site and freshwater lagoon including creation of 4no finger lagoons by extraction of rock, water pipes, electricity

generation and ancillary works

## 1. Background

- 1.1 To inform the Planning Applications Committee of the submission of the attached Proposal of Application Notice (PAN). A public exhibition has taken place in Lochaline and Port Appin Community Hall the latter on 10 August 2017, following an advert in the Oban Times on 3 August 2017.
- 1.2 The submission of the PAN accords with the provisions of the Planning etc. (Scotland) Act 2006 and was lodged on 1 August 2017. Members are asked to note this may form the basis of a subsequent planning application.
- 1.3 The following information was submitted in support of the Proposal of Application Notice:
  - Site Location Plan; and
  - Proposal of Application Notice which includes:
    - Description of Development; and
    - Details of Proposed Consultation;

## 2. Description of Proposed Development

2.1 Based upon the information provided the development is to comprise a silt storage site and freshwater lagoon including creation of 4(no) finger lagoons with the extraction of rock; water pipes; electricity generation and ancillary works. This represents a second PAN for this site, with the earlier submission underestimating the degree of rock extraction. The current PAN is not so specific on that matter.

### 3. Site Description

- 3.1 The site lies to the west side of the existing Glensanda Quarry. It site extends to approximately 276 hectares, lying to either side of the Allt Feith Mbic Attair watercourse, generally to the west side of the main access track between the rock quarry and its waterfront terminal on Loch Linnhe. High points within the site are above 500m AOD, with low points adjacent to the coastline.
- 3.2 There are a number of sites designated in the wider area, for example Morvern Woods SSSI, but these are unlikely to be directly affected by the development.
- 3.3 There are one scheduled monuments close to the site, Glensanda Castle. There are no listed buildings which exist in proximity to the site.
- 3.4 The site is not within the indicative 1 in 200 year flood risk mapping produced by Scottish Environment Protection Agency.
- 3.5 The site is not located within any international or regional landscape designations.
