Purpose/Executive Summary

3 Quarter 1 Monitoring Statement

- 3.2 **Income** Income received to date is within budget and relates to property and rentals, and income from the Nairn Highland Games.
- 3.3 **Expenditure** Spend to date is line with budget and includes electricity charges for the Pavilion and Links, insurance for common good property, advertising for the Nairn Games and legal expenses for feu plans for the caravan site at Lochloy.
