# 1. Purpose/Executive Summary

- 1.1 This report comments on the monitoring position for the Chief Executive's Office capital budget for the period to the end of September 2017.
- 1.2 The budget is currently showing 2 budget lines: the Capital Discretionary Budget and a single project, titled City Gateways, with a value of £0.066m, due to be completed by quarter 2 of the 2018/19 financial year.

#### 2. Recommendations

2.1 Members are asked to consider and agree the monitoring position for the Chief Executive's Office capital budget as at the end of September 2017.

## 3. 2017/18 Capital Monitoring, Quarter 2.

- 3.1 **Appendix 1** shows the monitoring position for the Chief Executive's Office 2017/18 capital budget for the period to the end of September 2017. The Chief Executive's Office budget has two capital budget headings for the financial year 201718: Capital Discretionary Fund (CDF) and Inverness City Gateways.
- 3.2 Since the last report to committee, the Capital Discretionary Budget has made grant payments to two projects: Mallaig Swimming Pool £43k; and Evanton Community Trust, Kiltearn Footpath £5k. It is anticipated that this budget will increase as the year progresses and more projects reach the point where they are ready to request part or full payment of their capital grant.
- 3.3 The City Gateways budget has an allocation of £0.066m. This budget is anticipated to be spent in full in 2018/19. Detailed progress on this project is reported to the City of Inverness Area Committee.
