Street Naming – Development at Reraig, Balmacara

Report by Head of Policy and Reform

Summary

The Committee is asked to **homologate** the naming of a new development in Reraig, Balmacara as Grant Road.

1. Background

1.1 A development of 6 houses is currently being developed in Reraig, Balmacara.

2. Consultations

- 2.1 The Corporate Address Team requested that the Ward Manager consult with the Community Council and local Members, with a view to determining a name for the access road to the development.
- 2.2 The developers proposed that the name should be "Grant Road".
- 2.3 Due to the small scale of the development, Lochalsh Community Council suggested that "Grant Close" or "Grant Way" might be more appropriate.
- 2.4 Ward 6 Members considered that as the street passes the houses to terminate at the new Kinlochshiel Shinty Club pitch, the term Road was appropriate and agreed on "Grant Road".

3. Delegation to Local/City Committees

- 3.1 The Scheme of Delegation grants the final decision on Street and Building Naming to Local/City Committees.
- 3.2 Due to an urgent need to allocate postal addresses, officers proceeded on the basis of the consultation with the Community Council and local Members and the matter is presented to the Local Committee for homologation.

4. Implications

4.1 There are no Resource, Legal, Equalities, Climate Change/Carbon Clever or Risk implications arising from this report. Once approved, the name will be forwarded to Ainmean-Aite na h-Alba for Gaelic translation and both names incorporated in signage.
