1. BACKGROUND

- 1.1 To inform the Planning Applications Committee of the submission of the attached Proposal of Application Notice (PAN).

2. DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED DEVELOPMENT

- 2.1 The proposal involves the development of a new build healthcare and life science building of approximately 8,500m2. This is a collaborative project between NHS Highland, the University of Highland & Islands and Highlands & Islands Enterprise to serve the Highlands & Islands.
- 2.2 The Proposal of Application Notice sets out that the applicant intends to hold a public consultation event on 14 August 2018 at An Lochran on the Inverness Campus.

3. SITE DESCRIPTION

3.1 The site is located within Plots 3, 4 and part of 5 of the Inverness Campus masterplan area. These plots lie to the north of the Inverness College building and south of the 'golden bridge' that crosses the A9 from the Raigmore housing estate that lies to the west. Directly west on the opposite side of the A9 is the Lifescan commercial medical research facility with the hospital and the first Phase of the Centre for Life Sciences sitting just beyond.
