“Can you provide a compilation of the percentage of children with level 3 and 4 ASN needs by each Local Committee area?”

Response to Mr A Jarvie

The number of children reported to have Additional Support Needs at levels 3 and 4 is shown in the table below for each local committee area and as a % of the total number of pupils in that area. The distribution of ASN at levels 3 and 4 across Highland is also provided for each local committee area. The data relates levels of ASN within mainstream schools as at May 2019.
