4. Ward 17

4.1 New commercial development, Inverness Airport

Members are invited to homologate one new street name for this development serving a new hotel at Inverness Airport. The name proposed by the developer was Runway View however although Ardersier and Petty Community Council had no issue with this name Elected Members felt that the name Fresson Circle was more fitting and better reflected the aviation connection after Captain Ernest Edmund "Ted" Fresson, OBE, who lived from 20 September 1891 to 25 September 1963. He was a pioneer aviator who is primarily remembered for establishing Highland Airways. The alternative street name Fresson Circle has met with no objection.

4.2 New housing development, Tornagrain, Inverness

Members are invited to homologate four new street names;

- South Coul Court
- Badgers Green
- Lagnachree
- The Neuk

Croy and Culloden More community Council had extensive discussions with the developer regarding the appropriate naming of these streets exploring several options. After discussion between the Ward 17 Elected Members, Croy and Culloden Moor Community Council and the developer, South Coul Court, Badgers Green, Lagnachree and The Neuk were agreed as appropriate names.

5. Ward 19

5.1 New housing development , Milton of Leys, Inverness

Members are invited to homologate two new street names for a new development of 49 new properties as;

- Monarch Road
- Northview Green

The developer proposed the names Monarch Road and Leys Green however Leys Green was regarded as a STEM name in use elsewhere. Inverness South Community Council declined to make comment leaving Elected Members to agree suitable names. Members were content with the use of Monarch Road however were asked to provide an alternative name for the second street to avoid possible confusion. Members agreed on the name Northview Green.
