Purpose/Executive Summary

1.1 The purpose of this report is to introduce the update presentation from the Change Team as they continue to work through their agreed strategic priorities. It will update Members on the presentation given by the Team to the Care, Learning and Housing Committee in August.

3. Training and support for schools

3.1 Since August there has been further engagement with schools through another round of Improvement Family days. The Team will feedback about the positive impact that these have had as Head Teachers worked collaboratively to interpret data and find solutions to a range of challenges.

4. Change Team engagement

- 4.1 In addition to organising and delivering the Improvement Family Days the Team have been working to improve processes and systems which currently take Head Teachers away from the core work that we need them to do. The presentation will also highlight progress in this area.
- 4.2 By the time of the next Care, Learning and Housing Committee the Change Team will be half way through their secondments. In order to capture progress to date and to highlight priorities for the remaining 6 months it is proposed that at the next committee there is a more substantial paper presented rather than the presentation used on this and previous occasions.
