**THE ELECTRICITY WORKS (ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT ASSESSMENT)(SCOTLAND)
REGULATIONS 2017**

As directed by regulation 23(1)(c) of the Electricity Works (Environmental Impact Assessment) (Scotland) 2017, notice is hereby given that **RWE Renewables UK Developments Ltd.** (“the Company”) has been **granted consent** by Scottish Ministers to construct and operate a **19 turbine wind powered electricity generating station**, the 19 turbines having a ground to blade tip height not exceeding 130 metres, with permission having been granted for associated development to include a control building and substation compound, 1 permanent and 2 temporary anemometer masts, approximately 13.75 km of tracks, 21 watercourse crossings, 4 borrow pits, a temporary construction compound, forest removal and cable trenches.

The Development is to be situated 15 km SW of Wick and 4.5 km NW of Lybster, in the relevant Planning Authority area of the Highland Council, and will have a electricity generating capacity exceeding 50 megawatts.

Scottish Ministers have directed, under Section 57 (2) of the Town & Country Planning Act (Scotland) 1997, that planning permission is deemed to be granted for the generating station and ancillary development as set out and referred to in full within the decision statement.
