### **1. Adhbhar/Gearr-chunntas Gníomhach**

1.1 Chaidh aontachadh aig Comataidh na Gàidhlig san Dùblachd 2021 gun deigheadh Aithisg Mheasaидh a' Mhòid Nàiseanta Rìoghail a thoirt chun na h-ath choinneimh de Chomataidh na Gàidhlig. Bidh Mgr Seumas Greumach, Àrd-Oifigear a' Chomuinn Ghàidhealaich, agus Mgr Alisdair Barnett, Stiùiriche a' Chomuinn Ghàidhealaich an làthair aig a' choinneimh airson ceistean a fhreagairt.

### **2. Molaidhean**

2.1 Thathar ag iarraidh air Buill:

- i. Beachdachadh air toraidhean Aithisg Mheasaидh a' Mhòid Nàiseanta Rìoghail; agus
- ii. Toirt fa-near do dh'aithisg Innes & Campbell Communications.

### **3. Buaidhean**

- 3.1 Goireas – Bidh am Mòd Nàiseanta Rìoghail (MNR) a' faighinn taic ionmhasail bho Bhuidseat Thabhartasan Gàidhlig fo Ùghdarris Chomhairle na Gàidhealtachd. Air sàillibh Covid-19, chaidh goireasan a bharrachd aontachadh tro Chomataidh nan Goireasan Corporra airson 's gum b' urrainnear am Mòd a stèidheachadh ann an sgìre Inbhir Nis airson an dàrna bliadhna às dèidh a chèile. Chaidh seo aontachadh air bun-stèidh gun deigheadh am Mòd a leasachadh is a chumail mar fhèis mheasgaichte le prògram 'aghaidh ri aghaidh' a bharrachd air prògram air-loidhne.
- 3.2 Laghail – Tha am MNR na phriomh thaisbeanair coileanaidh agus na phuing gniomha ann am Plana Gàidhlig na Comhairle, a tha na sgrìobhainn reachdail air aontachadh le ministearan a rèir Achd na Gàidhlig (Alba) 2005.

- 3.3 Coimhearsnachd (Co-ionannachd, Bochdainn, Dùthchail agus Eilean) – Bha com-pàirtichean, farpaisich is luchd-tadhail bho air feadh na Gàidhealtachd an làthair aig a' Mhòd Nàiseanta Rìoghail.
- 3.4 Atharrachadh Gnàth-shìde/Carbon Ciallach – 'S e tachartas measgaichte a bha sa Mhòd Nàiseanta Rìoghail agus bha na tachartasan is na gnìomhan an dà chuid 'aghaidh ri aghaidh' agus air-loidhne. Bha na tachartasan air-loidhne a' cuideachadh gus lorg carboin an tachartais a lùghdachadh.
- 3.5 Cunnart – Bha buaidh aig paindeamaig Covid-19 agus cuingealachaidhean is stiùiridhean Riaghaltas na h-Alba a thaobh sin air a' Mhòd Nàiseanta Rìoghail.
- 3.6 Gàidhlig – 'S e tachartas stèidhichte a tha sa Mhòd Nàiseanta Rìoghail a bhios a' gabhail àite gach bliadhna agus a tha a' toirt seachad àrd-ùrlar mòr airson leasachadh na Gàidhlig is leasachadh cultarail gu h-ionadail, nàiseanta, is eadar-nàiseanta. Tha am MNR na phrìomh thaisbeanair coileanaidh agus na phuing gnìomha ann am Plana Gàidhlig na Comhairle.

#### **4. Aithisg Mheasaidh a' Mhòd Nàiseanta Rìoghail (AMMNR)**

- 4.1 Mar a bhios fios aig Buill, chaith am Mòd Nàiseanta Rìoghail a chumail ann an Inbhir Nis san Dàmhair 2021, agus chleachd An Comunn Gàidhealach (ACG) dòigh-obrach mheasgaichte. Bha seo a' gabhail a-steach prògram ioma-chuimseach de thachartasan is fharpaisean a bha a' dol air adhart an dà chuid aghaidh ri aghaidh agus air-loidhne. San Lùnastal 2021 dh'fhashtaidh ACG seirbheisean Glamis Consultancy gus measadh sòisealta is eaonamach ioma-chuimseach dhen Mhòd Nàiseanta Rìoghail a ghabhail os làimh. Chaith an aithisg a chriochnachadh aig deireadh an Fhaoillich 2022 agus chithear i gu h-iomlan tron cheangal seo: [Aithisg Mheasaidh a' Mhòd](#)

##### **4.2 Measadh Buaidh Eaonamach**

A rèir toraidhean AMMNR thug am Mòd Nàiseanta Rìoghail seachad:

- £1.2m de bhuanachd eaonamach do dh'Inbhir Nis agus a' Ghàidhealtachd
- Taic do mu 14 obair co-ionann ri làn-ùine

Thug am MNR cuideachd spionnadh eaonamach do dh'Inbhir Nis san Dàmhair, àm a tha gu traidsanta nas sàmhacle a thaobh luchd-tadhail, agus thug e taic do thurasachd sa bhaile aig àm nuair a bha am paindeamaig air fior dhroch bhuaidh a thoirt air roinn na h-aoigheachd.

##### **4.3 Buaidh Shòisealta**

Bha am prògram measgaichte de thachartasan aghaidh ri aghaidh agus air-loidhne fior shoirbheachail agus chuir na com-pàrtichean uile fàilte mhòr air. Chuidich seo gus faighinn thairis air cuid de na droch bhuaidhean sòisealta a bha aig a' ghlasadh-shluagh. Uile gu lèir, bha fior dheagh bhuanachdan sòisealta is cultarail an cois a' MNR seach gun tug e seachad àrainn far am b' urrainn do dhaoine de gach aois ceangal a thogail às ùr le caraidean, com-pàrtichean, co-obraichean is luchd-tadhail às

dèidh għlasaidhean, bhacaidhean is aonaranachd COVID-19. Bha seo gu h-àraid fior dhaibhsan nach b' urrainn com-pàirt a għabail gu pearsanta.

#### 4.4 Buaidh air Cànan is Cultar na Gàidhlig

Bha am MNR soirbheachail ann a bhith a' togail aire mun Ghàidhlig, mu chultar agus mu na h-ealain seach gun robh:

- mu 2,840 neach an làthair 'gu pearsanta' aig a' Mhòd ann an Inbhir Nis agus mu 700 neach òg;
- bha cha mhòr na com-pàirtichean air fad a' fuireach ann an Alba, is a' mhòr-chuid dhiubh anns a' Ghàidhealtachd, Inbhir Nis, Na h-Eileanan Siar, Earr-Ghàidheal & Bòid, agus Dùn Èideann;
- bha 59% de chom-pàrtichean a' Mhòid air tadhil air Inbhir Nis mar an aon dòigh aca air com-pàirt a għabail anns a' Mhòd;
- bha 42% de luchd-amhairc a' Mhòid air com-pàirt a għabail tron phrògram air-loidhne a bharrachd air an 2,840 com-pàrtiche a bha ann gu pearsanta. Nam measg bha: 21% air com-pàirt a għabail tron phrògram air-loidhne a bharrachd air tadhlan 'pearsanta' gu Inbhir Nis; agus 21% air com-pàirt a għabail tron phrògram air-loidhne a-mhàin.

## Appendix 1

### The Royal National Mòd 2021 brought £1.2m boost to Inverness and the Highlands

*The prestigious event celebrating Gaelic language and culture had hugely positive social, cultural and economic benefits*

The **Royal National Mòd 2021**, which took place at Eden Court Theatre from the 8th to 16th October 2021, generated £1.2m for the economy in Inverness and the Highland Council area, as well as providing a huge social and cultural boost.

The 129 year-old event which celebrates Gaelic language and culture featured a variety of incredible competitions, performances and cultural activities, with 2,840 in-person attendees providing an economic uplift that helped support around 14 FTE jobs.

The national festival, organised by An Comunn Gàidhealach, elevated Inverness' tourism and hospitality sector during a quieter month in 2021, after the industry faced a difficult year due to COVID. Participants surveyed were also found to be highly likely to revisit Inverness in the future.

The festival took a hybrid approach in 2021, with events taking place in-person and online. The online programme proved hugely successful, as all participants welcomed the approach and it was shown to help people overcome mental health issues brought on by lockdown.

Scotland's premier Gaelic festival also strongly supported the development of Gaelic language and culture and overcame isolation caused by COVID restrictions. As well as being able to interact with fellow Gaelic speakers, learners and enthusiasts, attendees were able to reconnect with friends and family, bringing a huge morale boost to those isolated during lockdown.

**Allan Campbell, An Comunn Gaidhealach President**, said: "We are delighted that the 2021 Royal National Mòd has given the economy of Inverness and the surrounding area a significant boost in what was a difficult year for tourism in the city. It is especially gratifying because we were not certain until August if the Mòd could take place on a face-to-face basis.

"We are also absolutely delighted that the Mòd has played a crucial role in helping to offset the negative aspects of social isolation and some of the mental challenges caused by lockdown.

"We have seen yet again that having an online element is highly valued by participants and it has now become a permanent part of the overall programme, building on our experiences of 2020 and 2021.

"An Comunn congratulates all participants and organisers in making the 2021 Royal National Mòd a great success. We very much hope that the Mòd in Perth in 2022 can go ahead in full."

**Paul Bush OBE, VisitScotland's Director of Events, said:** "We were delighted to support the Royal National Mòd through Scotland's Events Recovery Fund, established by EventScotland in conjunction with funding from the Scottish Government. The Mòd shows the important role events play in our communities. It has brought significant economic impact to Inverness and the surrounding area as well as giving people the chance to connect and share memorable experiences through its programme of online and in-person events. Having such uniquely Scottish events in our calendar further strengthens the country's outlook and position as a world-leading events destination and reinforces Scotland's place as the perfect stage for events."

### **About the Royal National Mòd**

The Royal National Mòd is organised by An Comunn Gàidhealach (The Highland Association) which was founded in Oban in 1891 and has HM The Queen as its Patron.

The Gaelic word “mòd” means “a gathering of people” and this festival was first held in Oban in 1892, and it has grown to become Scotland’s premier Gaelic festival famous for celebrating our Gaelic linguistic and cultural heritage. Following Royal assent and now known as The Royal National Mòd, it provides opportunities for people of all ages to perform across a range of competitive disciplines including Gaelic music and song, highland dancing, instrumental, drama, sport and literature.

Restrictions imposed by the coronavirus pandemic made it necessary for the organisers to host a hybrid programme for the 2021 Royal National Mòd.
