3 Implications

- 3.2 **Legal** There are no Legal implications as a result of this report.
- 3.3 **Community (Equality, Poverty, Rural and Island)** Applications are considered on merit which includes compliance with Council Policies. The need to ensure that the residents of the former Burgh of Inverness are the main beneficiaries is paramount.
