## Purpose/Executive Summary

This report provides an update on progress of all cases within the 'Major' and 'National' development categories currently with the Planning and Development Service for determination. The report also details progress on proposals submitted under S36 or S37 of the Electricity Act 1989 on which the Council is consulted.

#### Recommendation

Members are asked to note the current position of these applications.

## 1. Update on Progress

- 1.1 Appendix 1 and 2 contains a list of all applications for Major Development currently with the service and awaiting determination. A brief update on the progress of these applications is provided, including a likely timescale for each case to be determined.
- 1.2 Appendix 3 provides a list of all significant Electricity Act applications. For many of these the Council has already provided its response to Scottish Government. Only once Scottish Ministers determine these cases will they be removed from the list. In terms of performance reporting, for these type of applications the Council is not required to meet the same target timescales as expected with planning applications.
- 1.3 Appendix 4 provides a list of all major scale planning permissions and Electricity Act consents issued within the last two years to provide members with an update on the status of these developments.
- 1.4 Details for any of these applications can be obtained through the Council's eplanning portal <u>http://wam.highland.gov.uk/wam</u> by entering the respective case reference number. The following abbreviations have been used in the appendices:
  - PCO Pending Consideration
  - PDE Pending Decision
  - S36RO –Raised an objection to an application for energy generation under the Electricity Act
  - S36RNO Raised no objection to an application for energy generation under the Electricity Act
  - S37RO Raised an objection to an application for energy transmission under the Electricity Act
  - S37RNO Raised no objection to an application for energy transmission under the Electricity Act

# 2. Delegated Refusals of Major Applications and Current Appeals / Judicial Reviews Related to Major Applications

- 2.1 Since the Major Developments Update Report presented to the last committee, the following major application has been refused using delegated powers:
  - None.
- 2.2 Progress with applications under the Electricity Act where the Council has raised objection:
  - 22/04580/S37 Skye Reinforcement Project Construct and operate approximately 110 kilometres (km) of new double circuit steel structure 132kV overhead transmission line and associated infrastructure. Following joint meetings of North and South Planning Applications Committees on 22 March 2023 and 08 November 2023, contrary to Planning Officer's recommendation, the Council raised an objection to the application. We await details of any further procedure from the Scottish Government's Energy Consents Unit, ahead of Scottish Government's decision on the application. A progress update request was sent to the Energy Consents Unit on 9 August 2024 and with their 12 September 2024 response stating:

'Scottish Ministers are currently considering the application alongside all stakeholder responses and representations received, and a decision will be made in due course on whether a public inquiry should be held.'

- 22/05533/S36 Kirkton Energy Park Erection and operation of a wind farm comprising of 11 wind turbines of up to 149.9m blade tip height, battery energy storage system, access tracks, substation, control building, 2 borrow pits, temporary construction compound and associated development for a period of 30 years. The application was reported to committee in January 2024 where, in line with the Planning Officer's recommendation, members raised an objection. Following UNESCO's decision to inscribe the Flow Country World Heritage Site, NatureScot have subsequently also raised and objection and will present evidence on behalf of the Council at Public Local Inquiry which took place on 20 November 2024. We now await Scottish Minister's determination of the application.
- 23/02998/S36 Ben Aketil Wind Farm Decommissioning and removal of 12 existing turbines and related infrastructure, erection and operation of 9 turbines with a maximum blade tip height of 200m, up to 20MW Battery Energy Storage System, anemometer mast, access tracks, up to two borrow pits, and all associated infrastructure. The application was reported to committee in June 2024 where, in line with the Planning Officer's recommendation, members raised an objection. A subsequent detailed report on handing was reported to committee in August 2024 which updated and refined the reasons for objection. A mandatory public local inquiry procedure has now been instigated with an inquiry scheduled for week commencing 23 June 2025. Ahead of inquiry the applicant has submitted an alternative scheme with a reduced turbine maximum blade tip height of 180m for consideration should the appointed Reporter find the larger turbines unacceptable. This suggested alternative scheme will be reported as a separate committee item for members consideration. This case will be determined by Scottish Ministers.
- 21/04984/S36 Tormsdale Wind Farm Erection and operation of wind farm for period of 30 years, comprising of 10 wind turbines with maximum blade tip height of 149.9m, access tracks, substation, control building, Battery Energy Storage System, and ancillary infrastructure. The application was reported to committee in June 2024 where, in line with the Planning Officer's recommendation, members raised an objection. A mandatory public local inquiry procedure has now been instigated and we await details of the Pre-Inquiry Meeting. This case will be determined by Scottish Ministers.
- 23/02320/S36 Melvich Wind Energy Hub Erection and operation of a wind farm for a period of 40 years, comprising 12 wind turbines with a maximum blade tip height of 149.9m, energy storage facility, access tracks, borrow pits, substation, and ancillary infrastructure. The application was reported to committee in December 2023 where, in line with the Planning Officer's recommendation, members raised an objection. The Council awaits details of further procedure ahead of Scottish Minister's decision on the application.
- 23/03945/S36 Glen Ullinish II Wind Farm Construction and operation of a wind farm for a 40 year operational period, comprising 47 wind turbines

with a maximum blade tip height of 200m, access tracks, borrow pits, battery storage, up to 2 anemometer masts, substations and ancillary infrastructure. The application was reported to committee in August 2024 where, in line with the Planning Officer's recommendation, members raised an objection. Application anticipated to be amended and re-consulted upon in early 2025. Thereafter, it will be reported back to committee in mid to late 2025.

- 24/02094/S36 Acheilidh Wind Farm Erection and operation of a wind farm for a period of 35 years, comprising of 12 wind turbines with a maximum blade tip height of between 200m and 230m, battery energy storage system (BESS), access tracks, borrow pits, substation, control building, and ancillary infrastructure. The application was initially reported to committee in October 2024 where, in line with the Planning Officer's recommendation, members raised an objection. Since then, the cumulative context has been altered with Scottish Government having consented Garvary Wind Farm 21/01921/S36. The detailed Case Officer's Report on Handling to consider this further will now be reported back to this committee for consideration.
- 2.3 For those cases under the Electricity Act where no objection was raised, and we are awaiting the decision of the Scottish Ministers, those cases will be listed in the appendix to this report only.
- 2.4 Progress with planning applications which are at appeal / have been called in for Scottish Minister's determination:
  - 23/00580/FUL Coul Links Golf Course Construction of an 18 hole golf course, practice area, access, parking, ancillary infrastructure and the change of use of existing buildings to form clubhouse, pro shop, maintenance shed and ancillary facilities. The application was reported to committee in December 2023 where, contrary to Planning Officer's recommendation, members were minded to grant planning permission. Due to the unresolved NatureScot objection, the decision on the application has been called in by Scottish Ministers. A public local inquiry took place in November 2024 and we await Scottish Minister's decision on the application.
  - 22/05178/FUL Fearn AD Plant Erection and operation of an anaerobic digestion plant and ancillary infrastructure. The application was refused under delegated powers in October 2023. An appeal has since been lodged and the appointed reported requested an Environmental Impact Assessment which has been provided by the applicant, and we await Scottish Ministers decision on the application.
- 2.5 The Planning Authority are not currently subject to any applications to the Court of Session for Judicial Review of decisions on major / national application in the north area.

3.1 The following decisions on major / national scale developments have been issued by Scottish Ministers / the Directorate for Planning and Environmental Appeals in the North Planning Applications Committee area since those reported to the last committee: • None

# 4. Other Applications

4.1 Having reviewed Scottish Minister's decision to consent application 22/02717/S36 Strath Oykel Wind Farm, Full Council decided on 27 March 2025 to lodge a petition in the Count of Session for a Judicial Review. As Judicial Review is a legal process, rather than a planning one, the case is being managed by the Council's Legal Service.
