#### 1. Purpose/Executive Summary

- 1.1 This report provides an update of key information in relation to the schools within the Nairn Academy Associated School Group (ASG) and provides useful updated links to further information in relation to these schools.
- 1.2 The primary schools in this area serve 832 pupils, ELC settings serve 142 children (107 in LA settings and 35 in Partner settings as at September Census), with the secondary school serving 685 young people.


